~ from Romans 12:9-21**

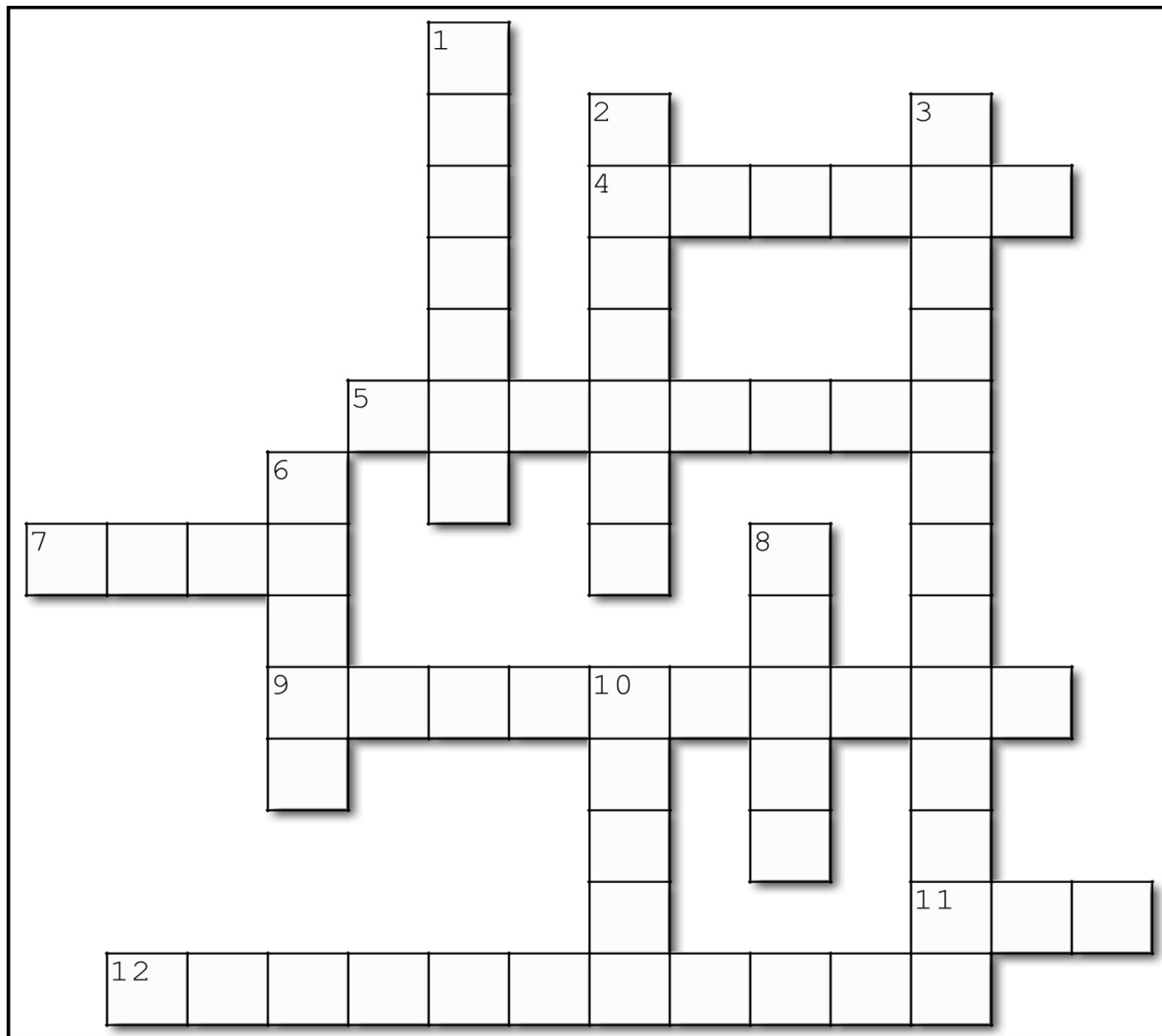
PRAYER
