where there is sadness, joy.**

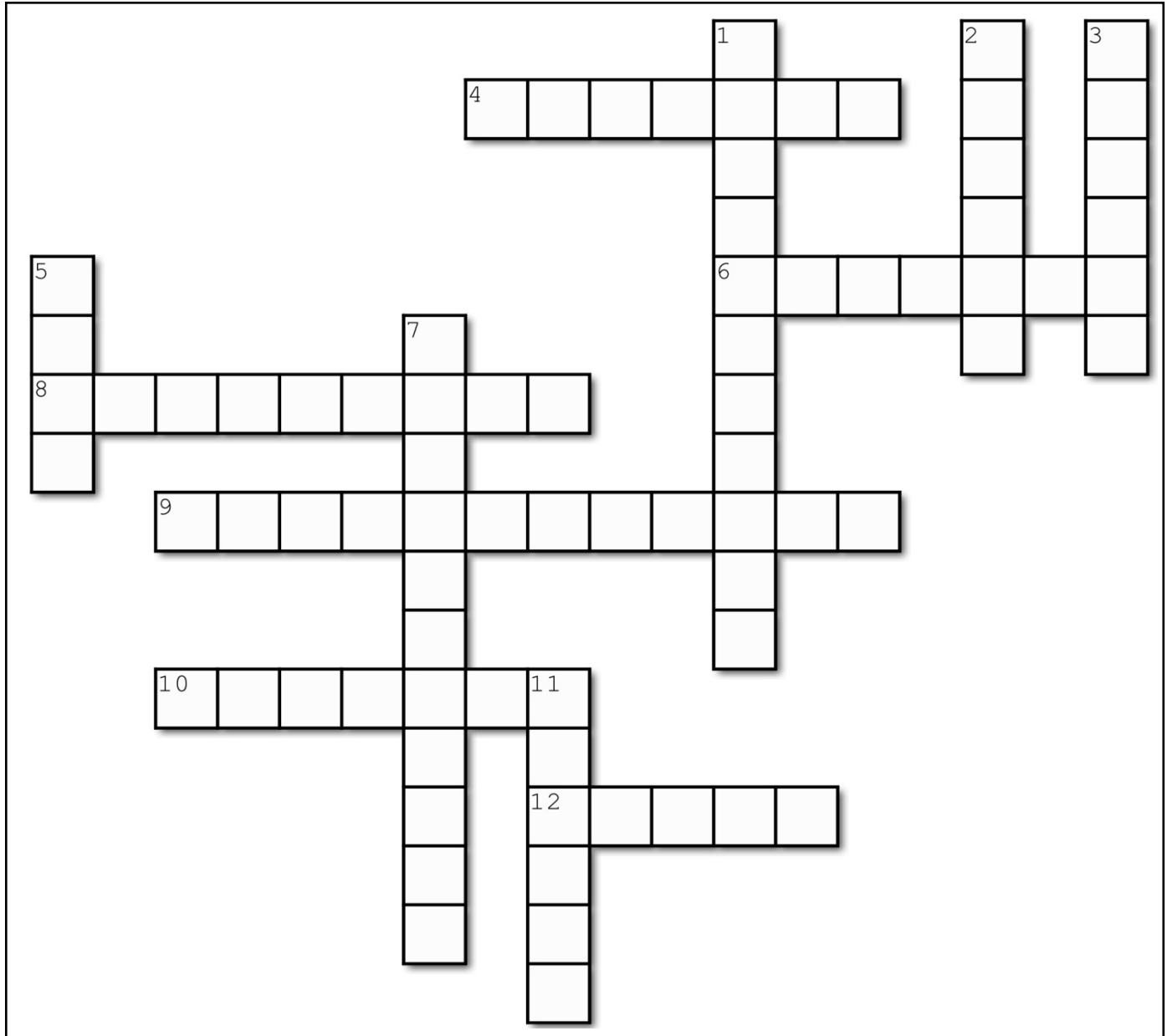
**O Divine Master, grant that I
